In its provision of after-school and camp programs throughout the year, Art City offers a safe and non-discriminatory environment where children can explore artistic expression, connect to their community, and find their passion.

The Board of Directors of Art City seeks a member with lived community experience to fill a minimum 2-year term on the Board of Directors. The Board supports fundraising and strategic development; it promotes the mission of Art City and supports the long-term success of the organization.

Requirements

- Arts interest and/or education
- Volunteer experience, especially in the areas of youth and arts programming

- Bring a passion for youth and/or youth arts programming
- Previous leadership experience and/or previous participation in Art City programs

Time Commitment

In addition, applicants will be expected to:

- Participate in a board orientation session (2 hours)
- Participate actively on one Board subcommittee (time variable)
- Be available for two hours each month for monthly meeting, once annually for the AGM
- Be at least 16 years of age and a resident of the City of Toronto
